İncelenmesinden de g¼r¼leceėi ¼zere, y¼r¼rl¼kte bulunan 20 Mart 2014 tarihli Passport Kanunu'nun kısmen revize edildiėi, Japon H¼k¼meti'nin halihazırda kullanılan pasaportlarda, pasaport sahibinin mevcut pasaportunda deėiŐiklik yapılması talebinin, eski uygulamada olduėu gibi ayrı bir sayfada d¼zeltme kaŐesiyle yapılmadan, yeni basılacak pasaport ¼zerine tatbik edileceėi, pasaport geçerlilik tarihinin de baŐvuranın isteėine baėlı olarak eski pasaport geçerlilik tarihi veya d¼zeltmenin yapıldıėı tarihten itibaren 10 yıl geçerliliėe sahip olabileceėi bildirilmektedir.

The Embassy of Japan presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey, and has the honor to inform the latter that according to the entry into force of the partially revised "Passport Act" of Japan on March 20, 2014, the Government of Japan terminated the service of making amendments by typing the items to be changed on the amendment page of the existing passport and started instead the service of issuing an ordinary passport with the same expiry date as the existing one (hereinafter referred to as "an ordinary passport with change of entry") based on the application made by the bearer in the case of change in any other items of the entry in his/her ordinary passport. A detailed conceptual diagram of the ordinary passport with change of entry is as attached herewith.

In the case of change of entry, the bearer was supposed to apply for not issuance of an ordinary passport but amendment by typing instead until March 19, 2014, and the passport amended by typing shall remain in effect until its original date of expiry. The 10 years valid ordinary passport issued on March 19, 2014 and amended by typing upon request of the bearer on the same day, therefore, will remain in existence with validity up until March 19, 2024, theoretically.

With regard to the official passport including the diplomatic passport, no amendment has been made by typing the items to be changed on the amendment page of the existing passport in both the official passport and the diplomatic one.

The Embassy of Japan has further the honor to request that the forementioned information be forwarded to the relevant authorities of the Republic of Turkey and that those authorities treat the passport amended by typing properly as a valid one and allow its bearer to pass freely and without hindrance and, in case of need, to afford him/her every possible aid and protection.

The Embassy of Japan avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey the assurances of its highest consideration.
