Dear Tour Operators

This message is to advise that attendance passes are now available for the 2023 Anzac Day Commemorative Services being held on the Gallipoli Peninsula, Türkiye.

Visitors and tour operators will need to register their attendance. Entry to the commemorative service will not be permitted without an attendance pass. Tour guides will be able to register and manage group bookings on behalf of their patrons.

Separately, all tour operators will need to register their coaches in advance through the online tour coach registration system here: <https://accreditation.teg.com.au>

Visitors and tour guides attending the commemorative service will go through an identification check, attendance pass scanning and security screening processes as part of the entry process. We encourage you to plan your journey and arrival times carefully to ensure you have sufficient time to progress through security.
